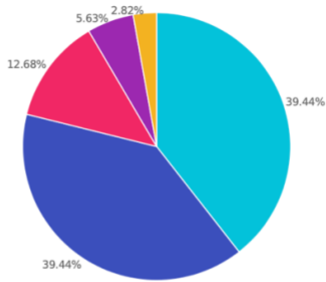


MSFC Communication Survey Results 2020

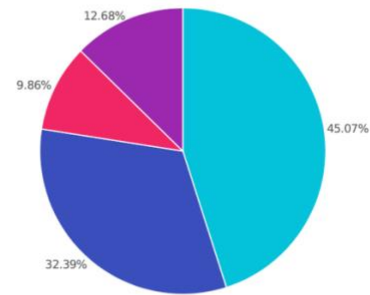

I feel informed about what is happening at MSFC.

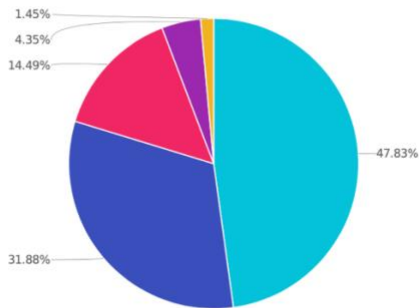

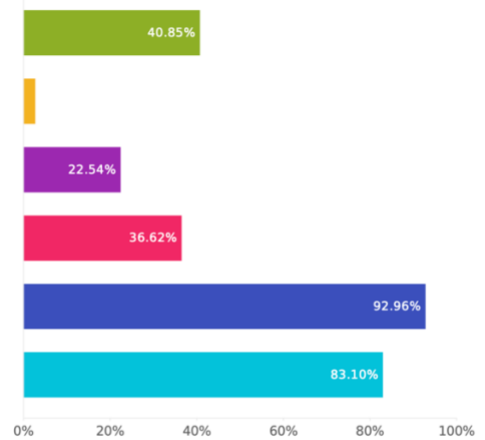

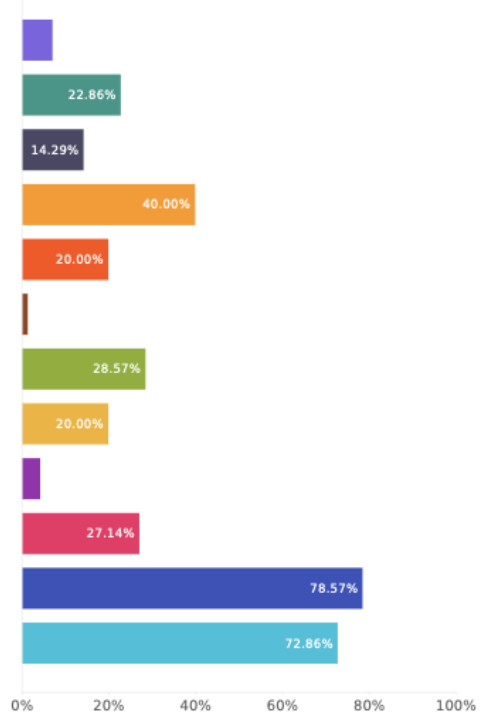

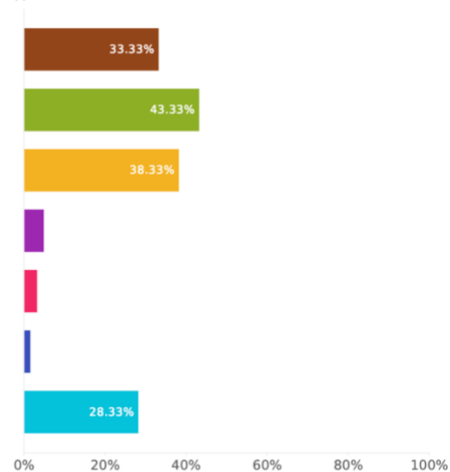

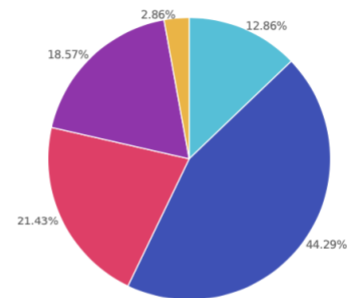

How often do you prefer receiving emails from MSFC?

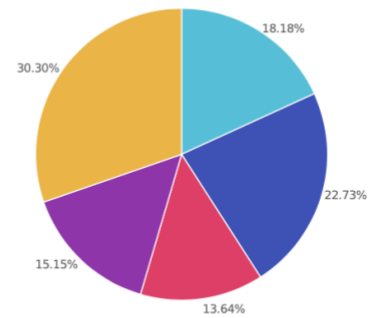
