ASAPH'S PROBLEM

1. Asaph wrote that his foothold in life was nearly lost. What did he state as the cause? (Psalm 73:2-3). Can you relate to Asaph?
2. How does Asaph describe the life of the wicked? (Psalm 73:4-12)
3. Asaph contrasted his life with the life of the wicked. How was his life different from the wicked? (Psalm 73:13-16)

ASAPH'S SOLUTION

4. When did Asaph have a turning point in his view of his life and the wicked? (Psalm 73:17)
5. Read Psalm 73:23-28. Then answer the following two questions:
 - a. What did Asaph either learn or remember about God's actions towards him? (Psalm 73:23-24)
 - b. What is Asaph's new way of understanding his life, the world and God? (Psalm 73:25-28)
6. What big question do you have for God? Will you now enter His sanctuary to be with Him?
